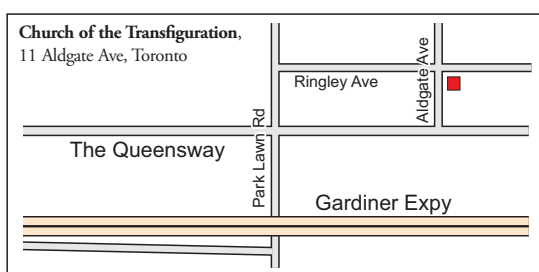


Join us to Celebrate the Anniversary of the Conversion of Poland

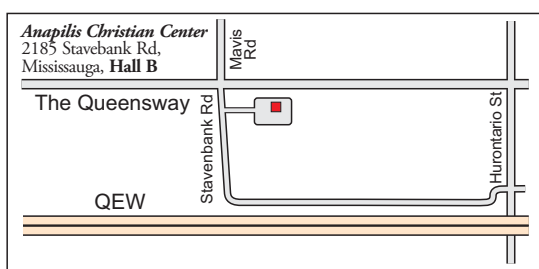
